

Thank you for your interest in private tastings and tours of our winemaking process and a walking tour (seasonal) of our vineyard. It's our pleasure to show you and your group where and how the grapes are grown and how the wine is made, as well as describing the varieties of wine we have to offer as you taste them

We offer private tastings "in season" (June through October), "late season" (November and December), and "off season" (April and May).

Depending on how many guests you invite, allow <u>1-1/2 to 2 hours</u> for the tastings and tours. We provide wine crackers to cleanse your palate between tastings. You are welcome to bring your own appetizers. We do have local cheeses (and a selection of crackers) available.

We will make every effort to schedule the date and time you would like to reserve. All other times and days are based on available scheduling. Note: Touring the vineyard and tasting wine is generally considered an adult activity. Although we do not prohibit it, we've found that guests bringing infants and children tend to have a less than satisfactory experience. If you do bring children, they must be entertained and under direct supervision indoors and out for the entire event by someone other than a person doing a wine tasting.



Our outdoor vineyard tours require the ability to walk up and down hills. Please wear sturdy footwear that also provides traction. The ground is not level, there are lots of bumpy spots and uneven surfaces, and the grass can be slippery. Going barefoot is prohibited.

You may want to wear a hat/sunglasses/ sunscreen/bug repellent and weather appropriate warm outerwear for your comfort. The vineyard tour is rain or shine, so during inclement weather, bring water-proof outwear, a rain hat, and shoes/boots with good traction. Much of the time it is windy here.

Note that the tastings do not begin until the production area and walking tours are completed.

Please advise the approximate number of guests a.s.a.p., including an indication of how many will be doing the walking tour and how many will be tasting wine.

Please provide this information at least two weeks prior to your visit so that we may staff accordingly.

No pets are allowed in the vineyard or in the tasting room.

Guests must be at least 21 years of age to drink wine.
